1. **Prelude Music** is usually prepared and arranged by the organist, and usually begins 15 minutes prior to the scheduled time of the wedding. (If a cantor/soloist has been engaged to sing, selections from selection 6A may be chosen as prelude music). If nothing is selected the soloist and/or organist will select appropriate music from their repertoire to perform.

2. **Seating of the Mothers Music***is frequently requested when the mothers of the bride and groom are not a part of the formal procession, and are seated just prior to the entrance of the wedding party (Entrance Procession). This music is often, but not always, dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary.

3. **Entrance Processional Music***is sometimes prepared as one selection for both the bridal party and the bride and sometimes two different selections. Mark "B" for bride and "P" for bridal party. If only one selection is desired just check the selection. Most of this music can be interchanged with the Recessional Music.

4. **Responsorial Psalm** is ideally sung by the cantor unless you would like a friend or relative to recite it. () sung () recited
